### **Announcement**

#### **Visa Exemption for the Russian Ordinary Passports Holders applying for Business and Tourist Visas for (30) days**

The Embassy of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar in Beijing is pleased to announce that the Government of Myanmar has decided to extend the period of visa exemption scheme for one more year for ordinary passports holders of the Russian citizens applying for Business and Tourist Visas for (30) days, from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2025 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026, and it is the fourth visa exemption scheme for Russian Ordinary Passports holders which terms and conditions for the visa exemption are as follows;

- (1) Holders of ordinary passports of the Russian citizens are allowed to enter and leave Myanmar by air through the Entry/Exit Points of Yangon, Mandalay and Nay Pyi Taw International Airports.
- (2) Visitors with such business visas are allowed to extend their stay permit with payable visa fees at the Ministry of Immigration and Population of Myanmar by applying through a partner company attaching with a recommendation letter of the concerned Ministry.
- (3) Visitors enter Myanmar with such visas are allowed to stay (30) days in Myanmar, and cannot be extended if it is a tourist visa.
- (4) All visitors must abide by the existing rules and regulations of Myanmar.
- (5) All visitors must abide by the updated rules and restrictions on health announced by the Ministry of Health of Myanmar.
- (6) Visitors are allowed to travel to any tourist sites except the restricted areas for security reasons.

- (7) Concerned Security and Immigration authorities may deny the entry permit if an applicant is found to be ineligible to enter Myanmar.
- (8) Visitors will be taken actions in accordance with the existing rules if a he/ she violates the rules and regulations on visa exemption.
